

Hancock Recreation Center and Golf Course

PARD has retained Cotera+Reed Architects to complete a condition assessment of the Hancock Recreation Center to evaluate the existing ADA accessibility, drainage systems, mechanical systems, structural, parking and landscaping. The condition assessment is intended to classify the existing conditions at the center as good, acceptable or requiring minor improvement, and identify those items in need of critical improvements. The condition assessment will be completed in the fourth quarter of 2012 and will be utilized to guide future spending requests and allocations at the recreation center. PARD anticipates completing a limited schedule of improvements to those items identified as critical needs in the 2013 fiscal year utilizing Facility Renovations and Improvements Funding from the 2006 Capital Bonds.

PARD is currently in the design stage for replacing the irrigation system at Lions. The existing irrigation system utilizing potable water will be converted to reclaimed water and will require complete renovation to meet all code requirements. The Golf Enterprise Fund will compete installation of the new irrigation system with in-house golf staff and plans to begin work in July. The renovation should last approximately 3 months.
